You can provide a lasting tribute by making a monetary contribution to the Library for the purchase of a book in print or electronic format. For a print book, a bookplate will be placed on the inside front cover of the book to identify it as a commemorative gift. For an electronic book, your sponsorship will be acknowledged on the electronic book resources page at the library's website. You will receive a letter acknowledging your gift. Notification of the gift (without identifying the amount given) will also be sent to the honoree or, in the case of a memorial, to the family of the deceased. You may designate a particular subject area for the book, for example, to honor a physician with a book in his/her specialty.
